Amending the Constitution

## Proposing an Amendment

- A $2 / 3$ vote of each House of Congress (ONLY Method used to date)
- A National Convention called by Congress at the request of $2 / 3$ of the States.


## Ratifying an Amendment

- Legislatures in $3 / 4$ of the states ratify an amendment.
- Each State calls a special ratifying convention; the Amendment becomes part of the Constitution when $3 / 4$ of these Conventions approve it.
